Rice: Takane Nishiki

Water: On-site well water, soft water

Yeast: Kyokai #10

SMV: +5 Acidity: 1.4 Amino acids: 1.1

No sulfites, no preservatives.

Other information

Suggested service: Serve chilled, at room temperature, or slightly warm.

Tasting note: Shy nose with hints of the sea. Very dry and light. Lots of character.
