**Rice:** Takane Nishiki  
**Water:** On-site well water, soft water  
**Yeast:** Kyokai #10  
**SMV:** +5     **Acidity:** 1.4     **Amino acids:** 1.1

No sulfites, no preservatives.

### Other information

**Suggested service:** Serve chilled, at room temperature, or slightly warm.  
**Tasting note:** Shy nose with hints of the sea. Very dry and light. Lots of character.
